

1822 Medium Regional Scenario

Three versions of the 1822 Medium Regional Scenario are given in these rules. The *Starter* version is intended for those with no experience with 1822. The *Standard* version is intended for players that wish to experience gameplay similar to the full 1822 game, but in a shorter duration. The *Advanced* version is more volatile and is the same as the previously web-published variant made available upon 1822's release.

- Starting cash and certificate limit
 - 3 players: £500, 18
 - 4 players: £375, 14
 - 5 players: £300, 11
 - 6 players: £250, 9
 - 7 players: £215, 8
- Bank is still £12,000
- Private companies
 - Starter: Include P1, P2, P5, P6, P7, P8, P9, P10, P11, P12, P13, P14.
 - Standard: Include P1-P18, but exclude P2-P3 (2P trains) and P17 ("move card")
 - Advanced: Include P1-P12
- Minor companies
 - Play with minors 7-21, 24
 - Starter and Standard: Start with M24 in bid box 1
 - Advanced: Start with M14 in bid box 1
- Major companies
 - Play with all majors except CR, NBR, and NER
- Trains
 - 14x 2-train
 - 7x 3-train
 - 4x 4-train
 - 2x 5-train
 - 3x 6-train
 - Unlimited 7/E-train
 - L-trains always cost £50. The cost to upgrade the first L-train is £80. In Phase 2, the upgrade cost of a 2-train is reduced to £70.
- Stock Market - The right side of the stock market (500-600) is modified from 1822.

 - Two less: 63, 769
